CORRIGENDA ET ADDENDA.

EASTHAM. Since Ormerod wrote the flagstones to the memory of the Rev. Richard Banner, 1655 and the Rev. George Becket, 1694, aged 63, have disappeared, doubtless covered by tiles modernly placed in the chancel bearing the arms of de Clare (!)

NESTON. The brass plate to the children of the Rev. William Ramsbottom, 1679, has also disappeared apparently.

WEST KIRBY, page 108. On the south wall of the chancel an ornamental tablet; arms, a cross; supporters, two eagles, coronet of 4 fleur-de-lys. H:S:E: IOHANNES VAN | ZOELLEN NVPER DE CI | VITATE BRISTOLIEN | SIS GENEROSVS QVI | OBIIT 3: TIO DIE SEPTE | MBRIS ANNO DM 1689 |
