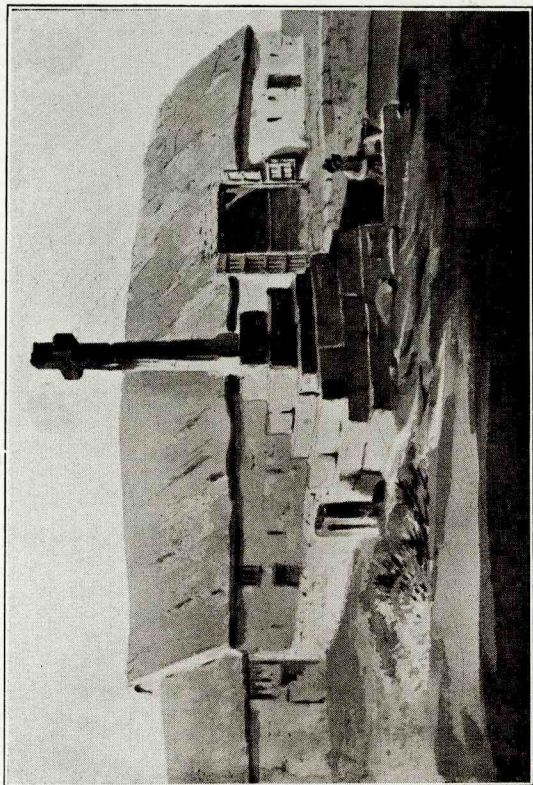

LITTLE CROSBY VILLAGE CROSS AND WELL, 1821.

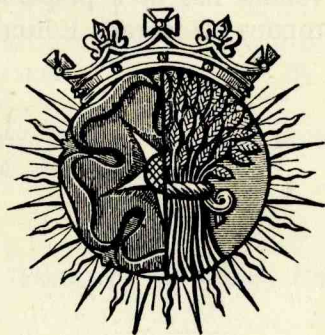
