THIS illustration shows the detail of almost the whole of this fine screen. A description of it will be found in Vol. 34 of this Society's *Transactions*¹ and in *V.C.H. Lancs.*, Vol. III. The date of the screen is c. 1500. It was pulled down in 1647 and set up and repaired by John Harrington, Esquire, in 1663.²
